Wine list

In 1790 a 25-year-old George Sandeman set up as a wine merchant on Birchin Lane, importing Ports and Sherries from Spain and Portugal. In 1805 he moved the business to St Swithins Lane, calling his company George Sandeman and Co. The cellars on St Swithins Lane were ideal for ageing and storing the wines, while an underground passage to the Thames meant the barrels could be rolled off the ships which docked where Cannon Street station is now situated and down into the cellars.

The cellars remained in use until 1967 with last vintage of Sandeman Port being bottled on St Swithins Lane in 1955. The cellars have hardly changed, but are now used for private dining, with the Barrel Cellar offering the largest private room in The City. The Medieval cellar is as it was from 1548 and is used for private tastings.
